Syrphid flies from southern Greenland (Diptera, Syrphidae)

Arthropods were collected by the author SK in the Narssaq area, southern Greenland, 1976 (see Koponen, 1978; 1981; 1982). The Narssaq region belongs to the subarctic vegetation zone of Greenland, characterized by the occurrence of the mountain birch (*Betula "tortuosa*"). The study area has been described by Koponen (1978).

The collecting sites for syrphids are: 1) Kangerdluarssuk 60°53'N, 45°50'W, 2) Narssaq, Dyrnaes 60°57'N, 46°05'W and 3) Narssarssuaq 61°10'N, 42°25'W. The material was identified by the author AH, and it is deposited in the Zoological Museum, University of Turku.

Altogether, five syrphid species were found. *Eupeodes perplexus* (Osburn) and *Sphaerophoria abbreviata* Zetterstedt, are reported for the first time from Greenland. Both species were caught in Narssarssuaq. *E. perplexus* has a Nearctic range, and *S. abbreviata* is a widely-distributed, northern Holarctic species (see e.g. Vockeroth, 1992). The total number of syrphid species known in Greenland is now 15 (cf. Vockeroth, 1992; Böcher, 2001).
